The TCC Workforce Education department hosted a first ever Community Resource Fair for Students on May 21st. It was a highly successful event with over 200 students attending and 25 community organizations tabling! Partners commented on the great diversity of the student body, the value of meeting participants in their own space, and connected with students interested in doing internships. Some highlights included: The Rainbow Center spoke with 35 students who hadn't known about their organization and were excited to participate; the Tacoma Public Library spoke to over 100 students to share the variety resources available at the libraries and signed-up many first- time card holders; Career Team's International Project Team engaged with 30 ELL students at the fair, and 7 have enrolled in the WIOA program and are now working with Career Advisors.
